For 40 years, HEI has provided independent, impartial science on exposures and health effects of air pollution to inform government, community, and industry decisions.

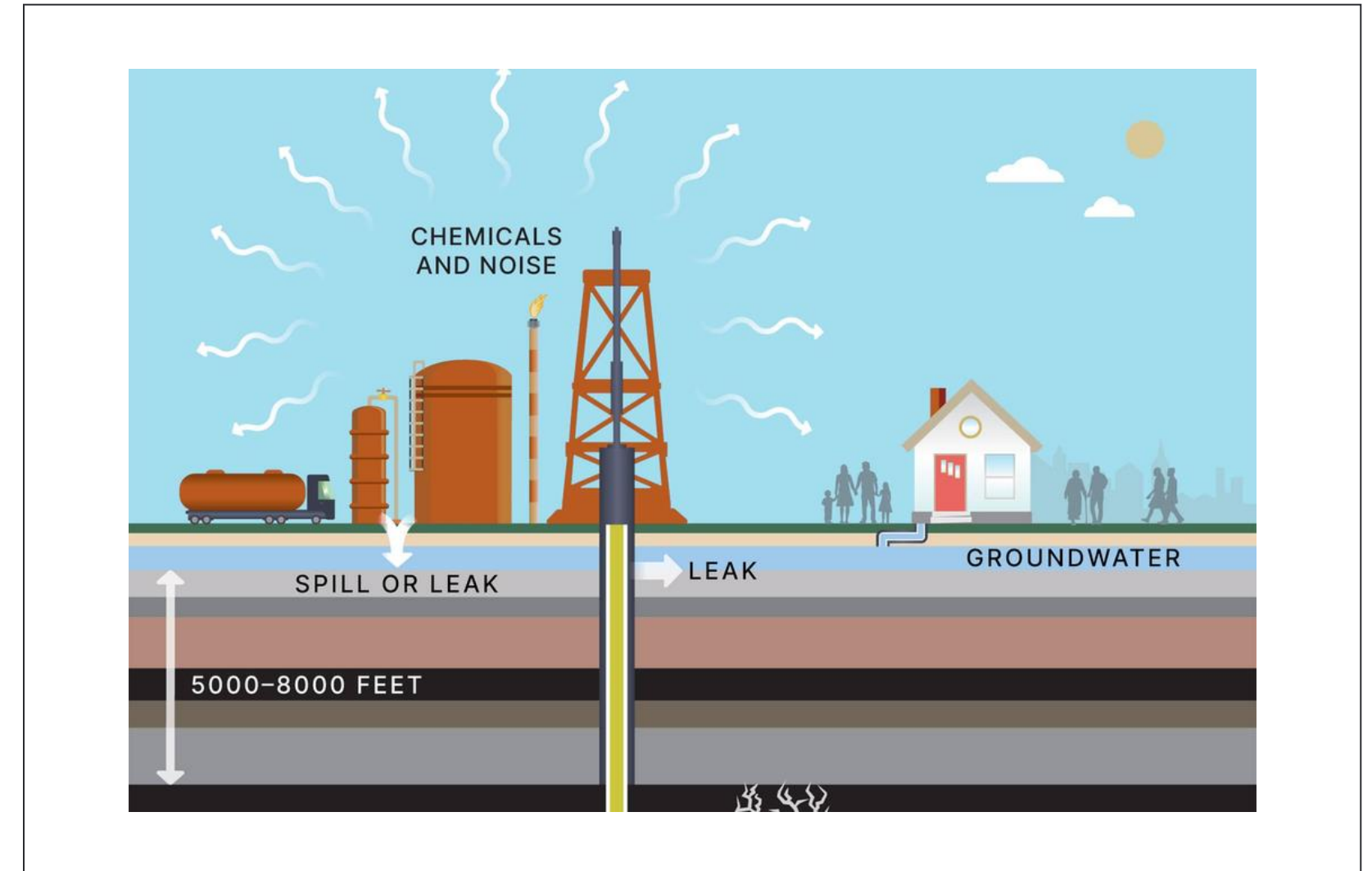

HEI ENERGY

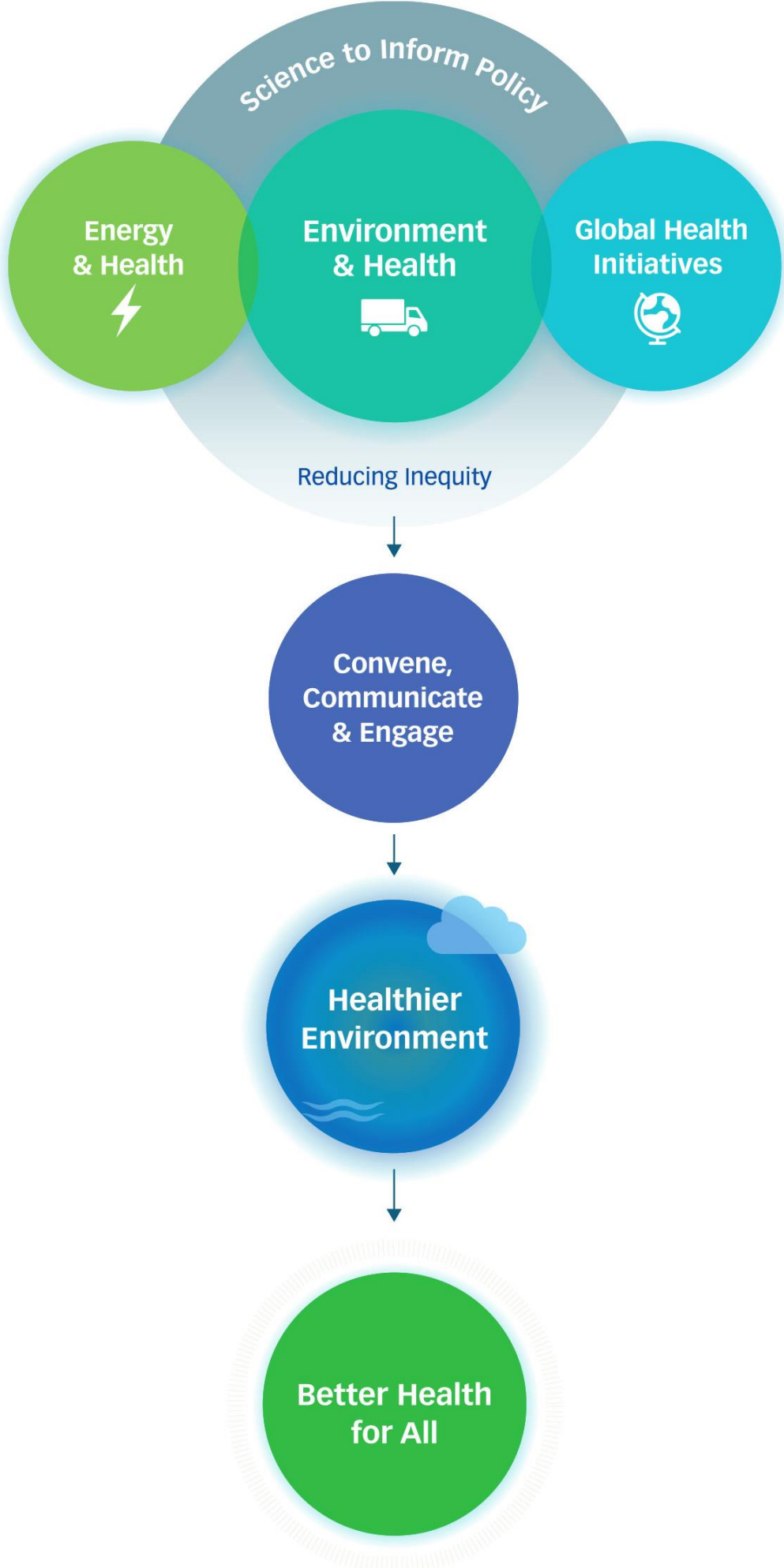
